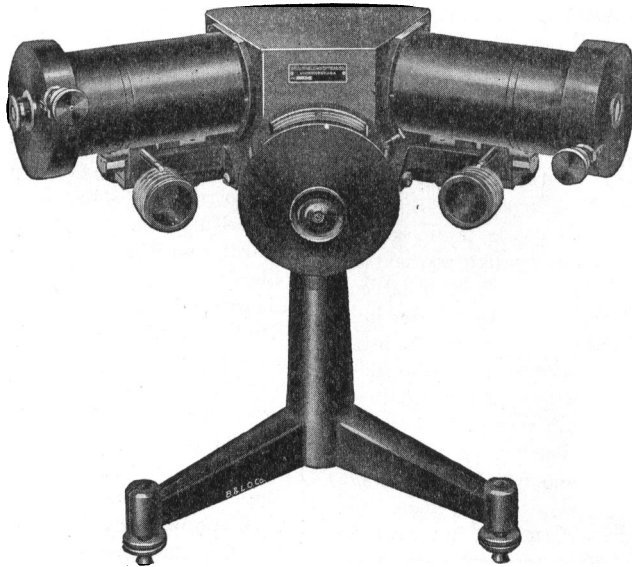

This Quartz, Ultra-Violet, Monochromator is of the constant deviation prism type with wavelength scale. All bearings and mechanism are completely enclosed for protection against dust and injury.

Angle of Deviation— $51^{\circ}$ .

Angle between collimator and telescope— $129^{\circ}$ .

Range—Graduated from  $8,000 \mu\mu$  to  $2,200 \mu\mu$  with room on scale for extension to  $2,000 \mu\mu$ .

### Admission

Medical and dental candidates must have completed three years of college work with special requirements in chemistry, physics and biology. The entering class will not exceed 40, men and women being admitted on equal terms. Instruction will begin September 23, 1926.

### Tuition

Charge for tuition will be \$300 per annum, payable in equal installments at the beginning of each semester.

## Johns Hopkins University SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

The School of Medicine is an Integral Part of the University and is in the Closest Affiliation with the Johns Hopkins Hospital.

### ADMISSION

Candidates for admission must be graduates of approved colleges or scientific schools with at least two years' instruction, including laboratory work, in chemistry, and one year each in physics and biology, together with evidence of a reading knowledge of French and German.

Each class is limited to a maximum of 75 students, men and women being admitted on the same terms. Applications may be sent any time during the academic year but not later than June 15th.

If vacancies occur, students from other institutions desiring advanced standing may be admitted to the second or third year provided they fulfill the requirements and present exceptional qualifications.

### INSTRUCTION

The academic year begins the Tuesday nearest October 1, and closes the second Tuesday in June. The course of instruction occupies four years and especial emphasis is laid upon practical work in the laboratories, in the wards of the Hospital and in the dispensary.

### TUITION

The charge for tuition is \$300 per annum, payable in three installments. There are no extra fees except for certain expensive supplies, and laboratory breakage.

Registrar of the School of Medicine, Johns Hopkins University, Washington and Monument Sts., Baltimore, Md.

Owing to an extensive building program about to be inaugurated at the Hospital and Medical School it has been deemed necessary to withdraw, for the next two years at least, post-graduate instruction during the year as well as the summer course formerly given during June and July.

## N. U. Northwestern University MEDICAL SCHOOL

Situated in Chicago in close proximity to important Hospitals with an abundance of clinical material.

**ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**—Two years of College credit, including a satisfactory course in Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Zoology, and French or German.

**COURSE OF STUDY**—leading to the degree of Doctor of Medicine—Four years in the Medical School and a fifth year either as Interne in an approved hospital or devoted to research in some branch of Medical Science.

**GRADUATE INSTRUCTION**—in courses leading to the degree of Master of Arts or Doctor of Philosophy.

**RESEARCH FOUNDATION**—The James A. Patten Endowment for Research affords unusual opportunities for advanced students of Medical Science to pursue special investigations.

**RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS**—Four fellowships of the value of \$500 each are awarded annually to promote scholarly research.

**TUITION FEES**—The tuition fee for undergraduate students is \$215.00 a year.

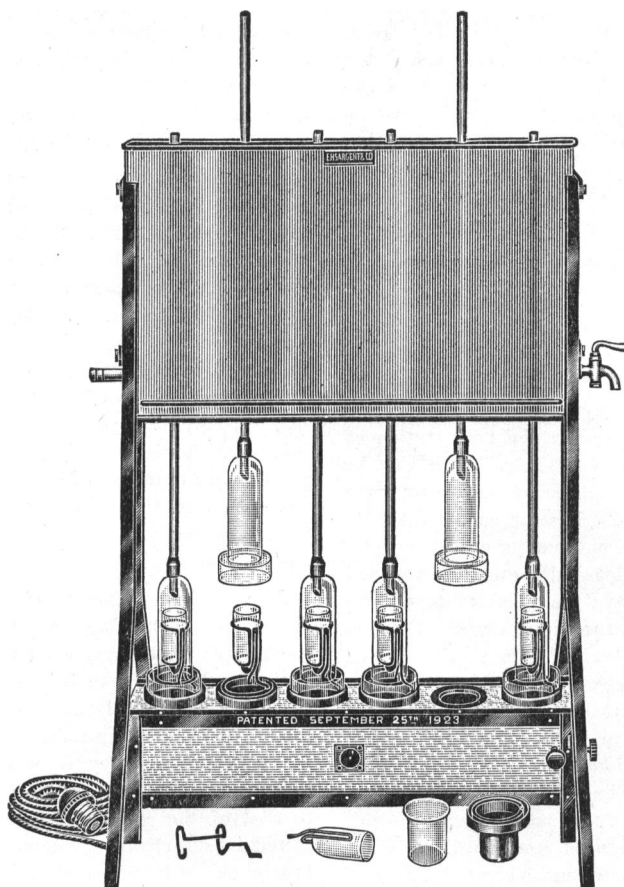
